The Sing Club is a cross community choir which has drawn people from all backgrounds, ages and abilities to share their love of singing.

Led by Siobhan Heaney who uses the 'SingTonicity' method, the group met throughout February and March 2018 to participate in workshops where they have experienced relaxation techniques, vocal exercises, breathing and stress relieving exercises, tribal sounds, group unison and harmony singing plus lots of empowering fun and laughter!

Not only have the group been working on perfecting a couple of much-loved songs but they have also, with the help of local singer/songwriter Paddy Nash, created their own song 'A Generation Waits' from shared reflections and discussions on the significance and subsequent impact of the Good Friday Agreement on our communities in Northern Ireland.
